

Essential Childcare Cleaning Checklist for UK Nurseries & Childminder



Young children explore the world through touch. They handle toys, touch surfaces, crawl across floors and often place objects near their mouths. Because children interact closely with their surroundings, maintaining a clean and hygienic childcare environment is essential for their health, safety and wellbeing.

A structured childcare cleaning checklist helps staff maintain high hygiene standards, comply with health and safety expectations and create a safe learning environment. By following a clear cleaning schedule, childcare providers can stay organised, reduce the risk of illness, and ensure that no important task is overlooked.

Why a Cleaning Checklist Matters in Childcare Centres:

Childcare centres operate most effectively when they provide a clean, organised and welcoming environment. Clean spaces support children's wellbeing, encourage positive learning experiences and help minimise the spread of germs and infections.

In busy [nurseries and childcare centres](#), staff manage a constant flow of activities, meals, play sessions and outdoor learning. Throughout the day, children bring in dirt from outside, drop food on floors, leave fingerprints on surfaces and transfer germs through shared toys and equipment. Daily Cleaning Tasks For Childminder and Childcare Centres:

Clean and Disinfect Frequently Touched Surfaces:

Children and staff frequently touch tables, chairs, door handles, light switches, storage units and play equipment. Staff should clean and disinfect these high-contact surfaces throughout the day to reduce the spread of bacteria and viruses.

Tables should be cleaned after every activity and sanitised before meal and snack times. Consistent surface cleaning helps maintain a hygienic environment and supports good infection control practices.

Maintain Clean Floors:

Children spend a significant amount of time playing, sitting and crawling on floors. Daily sweeping and mopping remove dirt, dust, food debris and other contaminants that can affect cleanliness and safety.

Staff should vacuum rugs, carpets and soft play mats regularly, particularly in high-traffic areas. Clean flooring also helps improve indoor air quality and reduces the likelihood of pest issues caused by food crumbs.

Clean and Rotate Toys:

Shared toys require particular attention because multiple children handle them throughout the day. Staff should clean and disinfect toys regularly to minimise the transfer of germs.

Items frequently placed in children's mouths should be separated and cleaned more often. Establishing a toy cleaning rotation helps maintain hygiene without disrupting daily activities.

Keep Toilets and Wash Areas Hygienic:

Toilet and handwashing facilities require regular cleaning throughout the day. Staff should disinfect toilets, washbasins, taps, soap dispensers, flush handles and door handles to reduce the risk of cross-contamination.

Regular waste removal also helps control odours and keeps facilities pleasant for children, staff and visitors.

End-of-Day Cleaning Tasks:

Reset Learning and Play Areas:

At the end of each day, staff should thoroughly clean all learning spaces, activity stations, shelves and play areas. This final cleaning stage [removes any remaining dirt and germs](#) that have accumulated during daily activities.

Staff should also inspect corners, storage areas and hard-to-reach spaces where dust and food particles may collect.

Clean Soft Furnishings and Bedding:

Many childcare centres & childminders provide nap mats, [blankets](#), [cushions](#) and other fabric-based items. These materials require regular laundering to maintain hygiene standards.
